REFLECTION FOR CHILDREN

When Jesus was a little boy, he probably learned Bible verses just like you do in Sunday School. In fact, we know he memorized Psalm 31 because one of the things he said when he was dying on the cross was from Psalm 31: Into your hands I commit my spirit. Even though he spent his entire life showing people how to live like God's children, some of those people treated him badly and put him to death. But since Jesus had memorized the scriptures, he knew God would rescue him from danger. So he prayed and put his whole life into God's hands.
